FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is a Parishioner in Good Standing?

Orthodox Christians 18 years of age or older who have been baptized/christmated into the Orthodox Faith, live in accordance with the faith and canons of our church, have fulfilled/met their stewardship obligation throughout the year, including fulfilling their financial stewardship obligation, and abide by the Uniform Parish Regulations and the bylaws of our parish is a member in Good Standing. Parishioners in Good Standing commit not only their resources, but their time (liturgical) and talent in service to church and to others.

Who is Eligible to Participate in the Sacraments, Ministries and Activities of St. Katherine?

Only members in Good Standing financially (Stewardship offering) and ecclesiastically may participate in scheduled Sacraments, ministries and programs of St. Katherine, and are eligible to participate in other aspects of Parish life, including voting in Parish Council Elections or Parish Assembly meetings, or running and holding official positions, such as serving on the Parish Council.
